#### **Student absences:**

We understand that absent tamariki from kura can be justified due to illness, tangihanga, Doctor's or hospital appointments, in these cases we ask all whanau to be vigilant in notifying the kura of any absent days that your child may have.

In the case of an overseas holiday, the Tumuaki must be notified at least a month ahead of the holiday,

The Ministry of Education considers regular attendance to be 90% attendance or above. This is the equivalent of having fewer than 10 half days or 5 full days off school per term.
