

Kura Uniform:

Our main uniforms have arrived, they will be sent home with your child this week, if you have not received uniforms by Monday please let the Office know. Whanau who have already made payments, we have had to source our No 1 Jerseys from another provider. We are currently looking into sourcing vests instead of Knitted Jersey as the cost of the Jerseys are too expensive.

Kotiro:

Polo Shirt, Polar Fleece, Black Skort, Black Shoes/Socks or Black Roman Sandals

NO Skuffs, Jandals, Coloured Shoes, Crocks or Trackpants are allowed.

Tama:

Polo Shirt, Polar Fleece, Black Cargo Shorts, Black Shoes/Socks or Black Roman Sandals.

NO Skuffs, Jandals, Coloured Shoes, Crocks or Trackpants are allowed.

Number 1 Uniform:

It is important that **all tamariki** have a No 1 Uniform, they are normally worn to Koroneihana, Poukai and other important gatherings that the kura have been invited to.

No 1's Kotiro:

Black Skirt, Black Stockings, White Short Sleeve Colar Shirt, Kura Tie, Kura Knitted Jersey, Black Shoes.

No 1's Tama:

Black Trousers, White Short Sleeve Colar Shirt, Kura Tie, Kura Vest, Black Shoes.

The Kura only sell the Ties and Knitted Jerseys.
