During the term and aligning with our Te Tiriti o Waitanga kaupapa at the beginning of the year, the tamariki and kaiako created our safety kawa Manaakitanga for travelling on our vans.

1. **Koorero i te reo Maaori** - speak Maori
2. **Waiho o ringa ki a koe** - keep your hands to yourself
3. **Me mau taatua** - wear your seatbelt
4. **Waiho oo kai i roto i too peke** - stow your bag under your seat
5. **Me noho tika i runga i too turu** - sit properly on your seat
6. **Whakarongo ki ngaa pou** - listen to your monitor
7. **Manaaki i ngaa waka** - look after the vehicle

Over the last week, some of our tamariki have disregarded these safety procedures.

Please help us to keep your tamaiti / tamariki safe and set good practices when travelling on a vehicle by reinforcing our kawa Manaakitanga.
