Thank you to our whaanau who continue to notify staff of our tamariki absences either the night before or early hours in the morning.

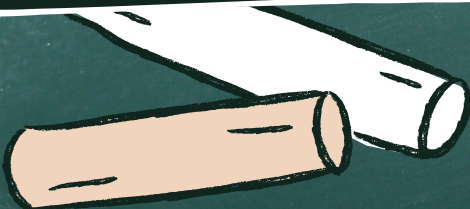
A big thank you for also providing a reason for the absence.

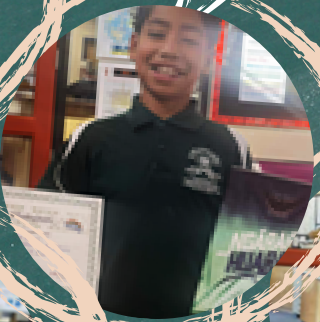
