Vans will leave Pukekohe, Tuakau and Te Kohanga around 8:00am.

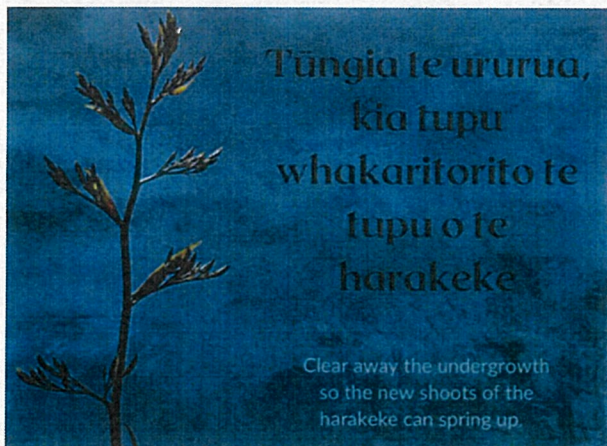
