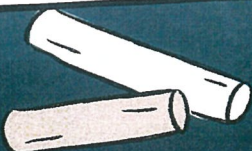

Heoi e te whaanau - please ensure that your tamaiti/ tamariki have morning tea and something for lunch.

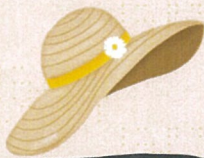
We never know, what time we are going to get our lunches.
